

# Gloucestershire Libraries & Information

**Library network** – We have 31 libraries in the County and 2 mobile libraries - one specifically for children - and 8 Community-run libraries. The library is **free** to join and you can borrow up to 20 books on your library card.

**Books and More!** – We have a wide selection of books, DVDs, CDs, information, and staff who can help you. You can reserve a book for free online and collect it from a library of your choice.

**Family Activities** – We hold regular pre-school story times, Baby Bounce and Rhyme times, and holiday activities in most of our libraries – lists of events are put on our website. We run the **free** Summer Reading Challenge for children age 4-12 years every summer holiday – great fun and taking part helps improve your child’s reading levels.

**PCs and Wi-Fi** – You can use a PC for up to 2 hours a day. You can book online, in person or by phone. **Free** public Wi-Fi is available in all libraries and in the 8 Community libraries.

**Virtual Reference Library** – We pay so you don’t have to! We subscribe to online encyclopaedias, dictionaries, historic newspapers, family history resources and other information. Try out Oxford Reference to help with homework, practice for your Driving Theory Test and even take a Citizen test! We also have help for setting up businesses.

**The Library App** – Download the **free** App now by typing “Gloucestershire Libraries” into your App or Android store. You will need your library card number and PIN.

**eBooks / eAudiobooks** – We have thousands of titles available for free download on to your smart phone or digital device, just ask for your PIN number or apply for it online. No late fees...ever! **eMagazines** – We subscribe to a collection of online magazines for library members.
